



# RISE Release 2.7.0

November 17, 2021

## Release Description

RISE Release 2.7.0 is a minor release. It included two changes to the RISE website.

On the RISE website, the styling of the Associated Items list on the Catalog Record and Catalog Item Details pages was updated to show the associated items by default and provide scrolling functionality. The Time Series Query page was also updated to provide more informative date range warnings and errors.

## Issues Addressed in this Release

263	Adjust display of Item Lists on Catalog Record and Item Details Pages	Revised the styling of the list of Associated Items on the Catalog Record and Catalog Item Details pages to expand the view by default and provide a scroll window for long lists of items.
536	Change date range messages on Specify Query and Generate Outputs tab	Revised messages and icons on the Specify Query and Generate Outputs tabs of the Time Series Query page to provide better warnings and errors about date ranges. Users will now see consistent messages on both tabs and the message text is more descriptive. The following situations are addressed by the revisions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Output is selected but no dates have been input</li><li>• Dates are outside the available date range (totally before or totally after the available date range)</li><li>• Date range has no data in it, but is within the available date range</li><li>• Date range is wider than the available date range (e.g. available date range starts after and/or ends before the selected date range)</li><li>• Date range is within the available date range but start or end of plot has no values (e.g. there are missing values at the start or end of the selected</li></ul>
