



# RISE Release 2.14.0

February 28, 2024

## Release Description

RISE Release 2.14.0 is a minor release. It addresses 18 issues, including 1 bug and 4 changes to the RISE Website and 2 bugs and 11 changes to the Data Admin UI. Changes to the RISE Website include adding navigation features to the RISE API documentation pages, enabling the API documentation to open specific page sections based on the API request URL, and implementation of site maps for better search engine indexing. Changes to the Data Admin UI include changes to messaging on delete confirmation pages to make messaging consistent across the application and upgrades and code remediation in preparation for the upgrade of RISE to Drupal 10 in Release 2.15.0.

1062	Implement Reactivity to Query Parameters for API Requests and Modify API Page to Add Navigation Options Back to the RISE Site	Added standard page navigation and breadcrumb links to RISE API Documentation pages accessed using a Request URL generated via an API query. Additionally, added functionality to the RISE API Documentation pages to open relevant sections of the documentation as specified in the Request URL.

1073	Implement Site Maps After Implementing Fastboot	A site map listing the URLs for all RISE webpages, including pages accessible from the left navigation menu as well as catalog record, item, and location details pages accessible through the Catalog and help topic pages accessible through the Help page search has been created to help search engines index RISE pages. The site map will be automatically updated daily.
1138	Address Page Indexing Issues	Excluded three URLs from search engine indexing to prevent search engines from trying to index pages for specific time series queries and API requests. The base API and Time Series Query pages are included in the site map for indexing (see #1073)
1144	Add Ability to Add RISE Menu and Breadcrumbs to Other Pages	Added functionality for developers of pages hosted in RISE to obtain and automatically include the most recent version of the RISE menus and breadcrumbs.
1027	BUG: Selected Locations Section Resizes and Makes the Page Jump	When selecting multiple locations on the Select Locations step of the Time Series Query page, the SELECTED LOCATIONS section changed size with the addition of each location, causing the page to jump. 1050	Enable Email Threading in Conversation View	Added information to email headers for emails sent by the Data Admin UI to RISE Data and Content Administrators so that emails will thread together when a user's email client is configured to thread messages.
1098	Button location on Delete Confirmation Page	Moved the location of the 'Cancel' button on delete confirmation pages so that the button is accessible without scrolling through the list of data associations shown on the page. Changes were also made to the messages on the delete confirmation pages for Catalog Records, Locations, and Parameters to make them consistent with other Delete Confirmation pages.
1102	Bug: Catalog Item Profile Source Code` always shows `sourceCode_ObservedProfile` regardless of value in database	A bug on the Catalog Item Add/Edit form was causing the form to always display the value sourceCode_ObservedProfile for the Catalog Item Profile Source Code, even if the value in the database was something else. Now the Catalog Item Profile Source Code field on the Catalog Item Add/Edit form displays the value from the database.
1103	Non-breaking Bugs/Deprecated Code Found During Development of Drupal 9.5 Upgrade	Resolved multiple code errors logged in the Drupal error logs that were encountered during development work for the upgrade to Drupal 9.5 in Release 2.13.0, in preparation for the upgrade to Drupal 10. The errors did not affect normal operations of the application.
1132	Remove Shortcuts Menu from Data Admin UI	Removed the Shortcuts option, which did not provide any functionality, from the Data Admin UI main menu bar.
1141	Update Delete Confirmation pages for Parameters and Locations	Changed the messaging on the Location and Parameter delete confirmation pages to be consistent with other delete confirmation pages. Additionally, this ticket changed permissions so Data Creators can now delete locations



		when the logged in user is the author of the location and the location is not associated with any records.
1142	Bug: Type Error in Contact Service When Saving Catalog Record with Empty Contact Value	A bug on the Catalog Record Add form was causing users to see an error message when the Data Contact field was blank when saving as 'Work in Progress'. Now users can save a Catalog Record as 'Work in Progress' with an empty Data Contact value.
1156	Upgrade CK Editor from 4 to 5 in Preparation for Drupal 10	Updated the CK Editor module to Version 5 to ensure compatibility with Drupal 10.1.6 in preparation for the upgrade to Drupal 10 in Release 2.15.0.
1157	Add Patching to Edit UUID and IMS Options to Support Drupal to Support Upgrade of Drupal to 10.x	Patched two Drupal modules to ensure compatibility with Drupal 10.1.6 in preparation for the upgrade to Drupal 10 in Release 2.15.0.
1158	Remediate Deprecations in RISE Module to prepare for the Upgrade Drupal to 10.x	Removed or remediated, as applicable, all code in the custom RISE Drupal module that was identified as deprecated in preparation for the upgrade from Drupal 9.5.0 to Drupal 10.1.6 in Release 2.15.0.
1159	Remediate Deprecations in Local Custom Modules (not RISE) & Themes - Upgrade Drupal to 10.x	Removed or remediated, as applicable, code identified as depreciated in custom Drupal modules other than the RISE custom module and themes.
1172	Changes to Catalog Record Delete Confirmation Page	Changed the title of the delete confirmation page for Catalog Records that cannot be deleted to make it clear that the record cannot be deleted and to be consistent with other delete confirmation pages.
