

# **RISE Release 2.15.2**

June 4, 2025

# **Release Description**

RISE Release 2.15.2 is a minor release addressing 5 issues, including 2 bug fixes on the RISE website; 1 change affecting both the RISE website and map interface, and 2 bug fixes to the Data Admin UI. RISE website bug fixes included removing the logic that caused catalog item titles displayed under the accordion on Catalog and Time Series Query page search results to be abbreviated, and fixing the 'Modeled/Observed' field on Catalog Item details pages to display either "Modeled" or "Observed". On the RISE website and Map Interface, the mini map zoom level on RISE Catalog Record Details pages, Location Details pages and the RISE map interface was adjusted so users can see both the pin and other surrounding features. On the Data Admin UI, an issue with form field validation was resolved and an error on the Parameter Edit Form was fixed so users no longer receive an error when clicking "update."

1401	Bug: Disable <findabbr> Feature on Catalog Search and Time Series Query Select Locations Pages</findabbr>	This change removes logic that caused catalog item titles in Catalog search results to be abbreviated with quotation marks when their text matched text in the record title, and caused record titles, item titles, and model run names on the Time Series Select Locations step search results to be abbreviated with quotation marks when their text matched text in the location name.
1403	Catalog Item Page Modeled/Observed Field Key Showing item- observed-value	Displayed text in the 'Modeled/Observed' field on the Catalog Item details page was corrected from item- observed-value to "Observed" and item-modeled-value to "Modeled".
1349	Adjust Map Zoom Feature to Consistent Percentage	The zoom level of the mini map on RISE Catalog Record Details pages and Location Details pages and the zoom level of the RISE map interface when a user clicks the 'Map Location' button to show a specific location on the map were adjusted so that users can see both the pin and other surrounding features. Additionally, the zoom (+) button on

1384	Bug: Parameter Edit Form in Prod and Test Returning Error Message When User Hits Submit	An error on the Parameter Edit Form was found during development and testing of another issue. When clicking "update" with or without making changes to the form, the following error message was encountered: "The website encountered an unexpected error. Try again later." The error is now fixed, and the form now saves when "Update" is selected.
1387	RISE Catalog Record Saved as Pending – Needs Admin Review with no Generation Effort	An issue with form field validation related to tag-input fields with refresh buttons that allowed users to save the form with required fields left blank was resolved. Now, required form fields with tag-input controls with refresh buttons do not allow users to save/update when required fields are left blank unless the value of the "Administration Status" field is "Work In Progress".
